IN THE SPACIOUS MASTER BEDROOM, designer Diana Bryant used neutral grays to balance the masculine and feminine. Yellow accents punch up the color scheme and connect the room with traditional schemes in other parts of the house. Classic elements include a pair of gray leather wingback chairs, a chaise before the window overlooking the courtyard, and monogrammed linens on the bed.
